Date: Tuesday & Wednesday, January 11 & 12, 2022

Message: Real Faith (Matthew 7: 24-27; James 1:22)

Bottom Line: Real faith is about doing, not just knowing.

Sometimes our faith can seem like the real thing, but it’s actually *counterfeit*. We aren’t supposed to listen to the Word of God and then go back to our everyday lives unchanged. Instead, we should go out and do what it says! And when we do, we’ll find that God changes us on the inside, for the better. The more you make faith your own, the more you’ll want to go out and put it into action!

Message: The Friendship Effect (Proverbs 13:20; 1 Corinthians 15:33; Proverbs 27:17)

Bottom Line: Real faith grows with other people.

Bad friends can corrupt us, but good friends help us stay strong and sharpen us into who God intended us to be.
